From March 3 to March 27, 2010, the Maine Council of the Atlantic Salmon Federation will be conducting a live auction as part of its \$150,000 campaign for the Penobscot River Restoration Project. The auction will be taking place on the Maine Council website:

Included in the auction is a one-of-a-kind bamboo rod made specifically for the project (upper right). The guides, cork, stripping guides, reel seat and the original Super Z ferrules came right off Everett Garrison's desk and were donated for this purpose by Hoagy B. Carmichael. David Van Burgel, preeminent rod maker for the Catskills Museum, Maine Council ASF Director, and the force behind this project crafted the rod. If you look closely at the clear silk wraps on the ferrules, you'll know why Hoagy wrote back, "Wow – Mr. Garrison would be pleased." Also available are a Hardy Marquis Reel, an Orvis rod and reel outfit, a framed Tom Hennessey print, and a Jonathan Larrabee custom vom Hofe salmon reel (lower right).
