Ladies / Gentlemen:

The Board of Directors of CRSA has authorized a trip of our CRSA members to Limestone Trout Club and LTC has agreed to host us for a trout fishing adventure at the club's property in northwest Connecticut.

The date will be Friday, May 11, 2018.

Limestone Trout Club is regarded as having one of the outstanding still water fisheries in the northeast with 6 ponds, 3 of which are deep water former limestone quarries. The 96 acre property includes a clubhouse, a cabin, and various maintenance buildings in a largely wooded setting. Two of the ponds are equipped with rowboats. LTC is a fly fishing club.

The day will begin at 9:00 AM and our fishing will continue through 4:00 PM. Our invitation is for 20 rods so the first 20 CRSA members who register will be accepted. Fishing will be catch and release, except that each angler may keep one fish of 17 inches or less. There will be a \$35 fee per member and \$40 for a guest, which includes morning coffee, lunch and beverages. A wine tasting will be provided by High Hook Vineyards and prizes will be awarded for largest, most and golden trout caught.
